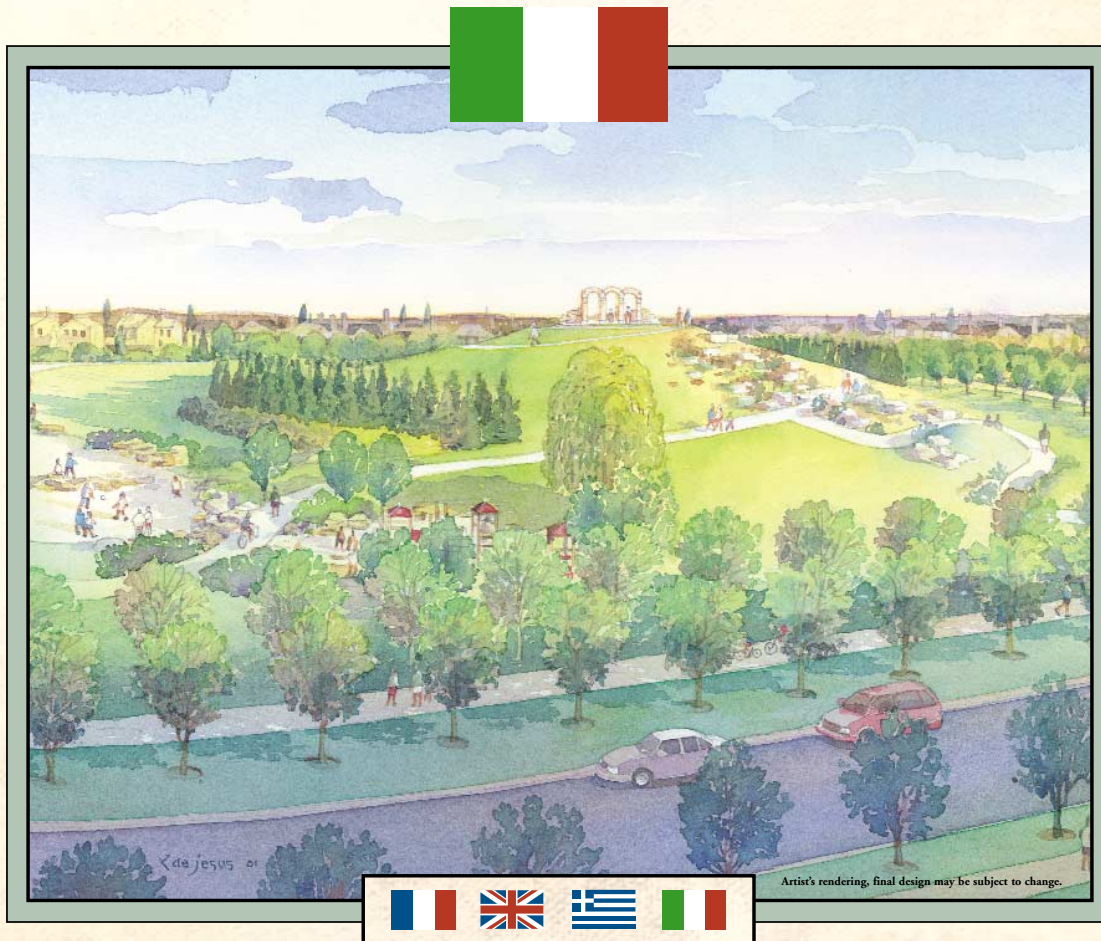


ELGIN HILL • BELLOSGUARDO

“BELLOSGUARDO – BEAUTIFUL SITE”



Elgin Hill is the central feature of Elgin Village that residents can enjoy all year round.

Elgin Hill comprises approximately 6 acres and is extensively landscaped featuring a play area, picnic tables and lots of park space to enjoy during the summer months. And when the snow flies, families can enjoy an afternoon of tobogganing on the biggest toboggan run in the area. The total length of the toboggan run stretches 295 feet.

From the top of Elgin Hill, which is over 30 feet up, residents can relax on benches strategically placed to take in the panoramic view of McKenzie Towne. The top of the hill is

crowned with soft landscaping and highlighted by three hand-carved tinstone arches, which are reminiscent of medieval castle ruins. Boulders are placed along the western slope of the hill to appear as if they tumbled down from the castle ruins hundreds of years ago.

Carma Developers has named Elgin Hill “Bellosguardo,” meaning “Beautiful Site,” after the residence of the famous Italian scientist Galileo, located in Florence, Italy.

Residents are sure to enjoy this wonderful community park in the centre of Elgin Village.
