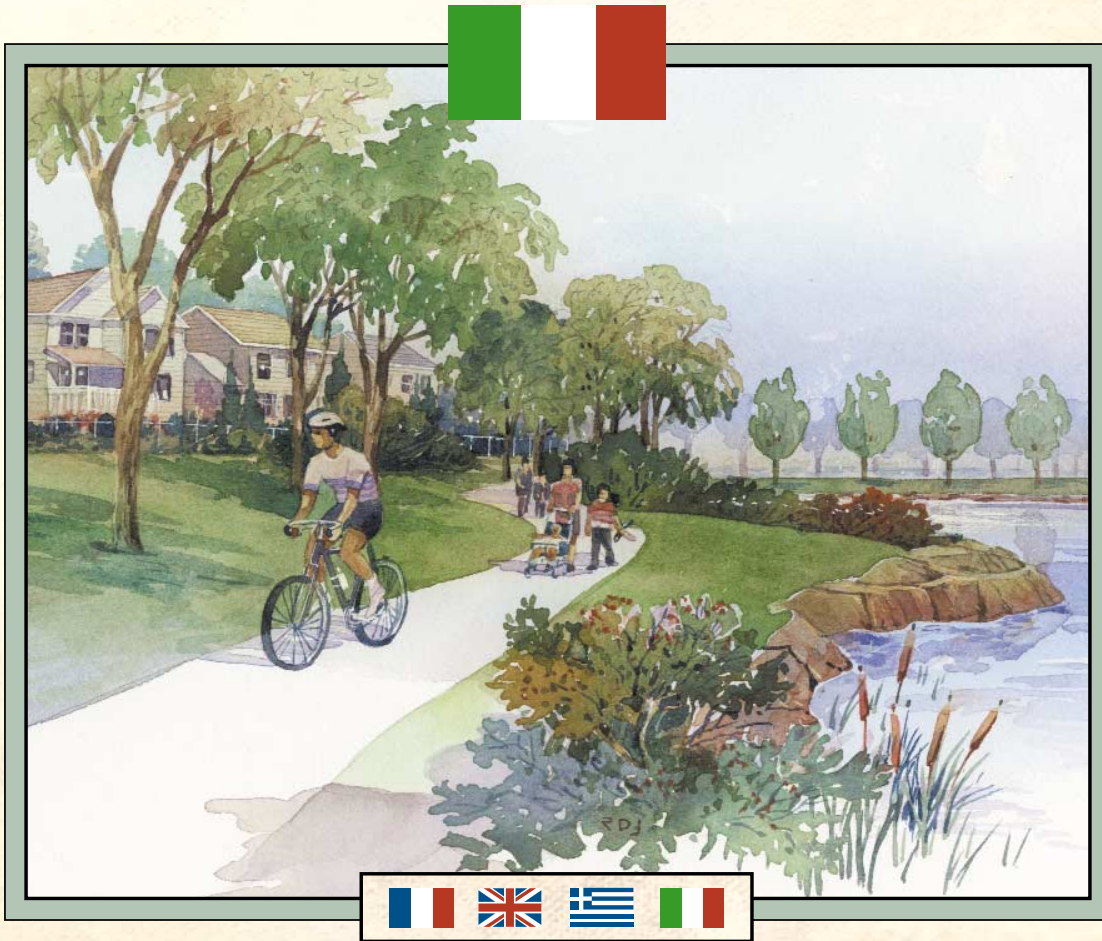


# THE POND AT ELGIN VILLAGE



The Pond is a remarkable amenity for the residents of Elgin Village. Connected to Elgin Village via the Pathways at Elgin Hill, all homeowners and guests can enjoy the recreational opportunities that the pond and its adjacent park provide.

Although the storm-pond is manmade, it has developed into a natural environment that promotes the growth of bulrushes and cattails and attracts ducks, geese and other waterfowl.

The pond encompasses 30 acres – including 20 acres of water surface and 10 acres of adjacent landscaping. The shoreline has been finished with a “hard rock” edge

treatment and the shallow edges of the pond are decorated with pond lilies and shaded by strategically planted trees.

A 10-acre, landscaped park surrounds the pond and a pathway system winds its way past benches and other lookouts along the pond’s edge. The pathway system is an ideal setting for numerous scenic outdoor activities such as cycling, jogging, walking, roller-blading, bird-watching and photography.

The pond also provides an ideal environment for canoeing and other non-motorized boating activities such as rowing and sailing.
